

## Dear Habitat supporter,

Habitat for Humanity International's (HFHI) Veterans Build and AmeriCorps members are joining forces for the first ever National Service Blitz hosted by Fort Hood Area Habitat for Humanity (FHAHFH) from May 14, 2023 – May 19, 2023. This effort will take place the week leading up to National Armed Forces Day as a celebration of national and military service and to bring attention to the issues of safe, affordable housing in the United States. Roughly 200 AmeriCorps members and 100 Veterans Build volunteers will serve alongside veterans to collectively impact the local community's housing needs.

Our vision is to bring both Habitat "branches" together in an effort to maximize our impact and highlight what it means to be #CentralTexasStrong. With a veteran-focused conference held in tandem with an accredited blitz build, this event hosts an array of opportunities for community growth, involvement, and honoring our veterans. Volunteers will build alongside Habitat Homebuyers who are eager to establish themselves in this community as homeowners; and Veteran Build representatives will engage in learning/sharing services for veteran clients. All guests will get to regroup and immerse themselves in our military-blended community with a guided tour of Fort Hood. FHAHFH is expecting to host an estimated 300+ guests from Habitat affiliates across all 50 states for this nationally publicized event. This is a massive effort and we need local support now more than ever!

#### 5/14/2023 - 5/19/2023

#### Five days focused on serving veterans.

This event will highlight our community partnership with Fort Cavazos and educate about available veteran resources. Each day will feature activities centered around one of five veteran focused service pillars.

#### Employ

Addressing employment barriers veterans face when integrating back into the civilian sector, learning about available transitioning resources from Veteran Service Organizations (VSO's), and employment/ trade-skills opportunities.

#### Engage

Focusing on the importance of staying active in serving your community after serving your country. We will hear from active-duty soldiers who are active Habitat volunteers, and VSO's who partner in our volunteer efforts.

#### Educate

Educating on being Person Centered Trauma Informed (PCTI), understanding the importance of community partnerships, and learning about additional services/resources available to veterans.



#### Honor

Honoring those who have served and who are currently serving our great nation. Participants will have an opportunity to interact with active duty and post-service veterans and experience a tour of Fort Cavazos.

#### Build

Impacting veterans through home construction and addressing housing issues for active duty and post-service veterans. We will be featuring best practices for Critical Home Repair Programs and highlighting "She Served" Women Build Events. Guests will also get to hear from grant officers of veteran home repair programs.


## Learn AND teach!
